Using a quote for evidence

Step 1: Select a quote from a source. In this example, I've used a line from "The Tell-Tale Heart", in which the narrator thinks he hears the heartbeat of his victim.	"I felt that I must scream or die! and now again!hark! louder! louder! louder! louder!"
Step 2: Highlight the most impactful part of the quote, the part that connects the most with your topic sentence.	"I felt that I must scream or die! and now again!hark! louder! louder! louder! louder!"
The topic sentence for this quote is on the UoE component: Unreliable Narrator	
Step 3: Embed the quote in a complete sentence, giving context and TAG.	In one example, from Poe's "The Tell-Tale Heart", the narrator shows his unreliability when he claims he can hear the dead man's heartbeat.
Don't forget the transitional phrase to help move from your topic sentence to your quote.	He cries "again!hark! Louder! Louder! Louder!".
