Using a quote for evidence

<p>Step 1: Select a quote from a source. In this example, I've used a line from "The Tell-Tale Heart", in which the narrator thinks he hears the heartbeat of his victim.</p>	<p>"I felt that I must scream or die! and now --again! --hark! louder! louder! louder! louder!"</p>
<p>Step 2: Highlight the most impactful part of the quote, the part that connects the most with your topic sentence.</p> <p>The topic sentence for this quote is on the UoE component: Unreliable Narrator</p>	<p>"I felt that I must scream or die! and now --again! --hark! louder! louder! louder! louder!"</p>
<p>Step 3: Embed the quote in a complete sentence, giving context and TAG.</p> <p>Don't forget the transitional phrase to help move from your topic sentence to your quote.</p>	<p>In one example, from Poe's "The Tell-Tale Heart", the narrator shows his unreliability when he claims he can hear the dead man's heartbeat. He cries "--again!---hark! Louder! Louder! Louder!"</p>
